CCHS is conducted by Statistics Canada.

This compilation of smoking trends by the Canadian Cancer Society was updated August 6, 2020.

The margin of error for current smoking nationally in 2019 is +/- 0.5%.

The margin of error is higher for subpopulations. For current smoking by province, the margin of error in 2019 ranges from +/- 0.8% in Ontario to +/- 3.2% in PEI.
